## **Jeff Lindsey Communities Builds Catch-a-Dream Home at Fort Benning; Donates \$60,000 to Catch-A-Dream Foundation**

*Senoia, GA - May 27, 2010* – All of the proceeds from a Jeff Lindsey Communities home near Fort Benning were donated recently to the Catch-A-Dream Foundation, an organization that provides life-changing outdoor related experiences for youth, age 18 years and younger, who are battling life threatening illnesses. Participation in the project helped realize the home building and development company's motto, "Live Your Dream."

The home, built in the Bradley Oaks community in Fort Mitchell, AL near Fort Benning was sold to a military family who relocated to the area as part of the base realignment and closure (BRAC) from Fort Knox in Kentucky. Owner Jeff Lindsey persuaded most of the subcontractors on the project to donate their time and provide labor at cost.

"The home actually sold for \$152,600 and as a result, we were able to raise \$60,000 for the foundation," Lindsey said.

The "Catch-A-Dream" home idea arose when Jeff Lindsey was challenged by Mark and Terry Drury of Drury Outdoors to raise money for the foundation. Lindsey was joined by five-time Ultimate Fighting heavyweight champion Tim Sylvia and raised money along with three other teams. St. Louis Cardinals pitcher Adam Wainwright, former world bull riding champion J.W. Hart, and Aaron Lewis, the lead singer of the rock band "Staind" also participated..

The Bruce Brady Memorial Catch-A-Dream Foundation is headquartered at Mississippi State University, and operates as a unique component of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries. The goals of this extraordinary organization are to memorialize Brady and help make his vision a reality by granting deserving children an outdoor adventure that will provide them with a memorable, encouraging and uplifting experience.
